Help! No Heat/Furnace Maintenance

With colder weather approaching, we would like to remind you that is is considered a maintenance emaergency if you have no heat when the temperature is below 50 degrees. If you find yourself in this situation after hours, weekends, and holidays, call the maintenance emergency number at 517-202-7820 and the staff will respond as soon as possible. Also, if you suspect you have a furnace problem, don't wait for it to become an emergency, call the Office to schedule a maintenance check. In prepartion for colder weather, please try turning on your thermostat early in the month and make sure your system is functioning properly. Remember that the first time the furnace comes on you may experience a "funny" smell from the dust. If you have any problems call the Office immediately.

Exterior Hoses

If you have a garden hose, please deconnect and store the hose properly by October 31st. Hoses need to be disconnected to help prevent the water lines from freezing and rupturing. Any damage caused due to a hose not being disconnected will be charged back to the member.

Fall Clean Up

With the change of season coming, it is time to start cleaning out your flower beds and common areas. After the first "Big" frost, most of the annual flowers planted will need to be pulled. Please help Village continue to look neat and clean by taking care of your flower bed areas. We ask you to not put your yard waste in the dumpsters, but rather in the bed of the truck located by the Office garage. Remember yard waste must be in paper bags. Thanks for helping keep Village looking neat.



Summer Items
